PURPOSE

Sheriff's Office General Order 26.02 Shooting Review Board has been incorporated in its entirety into their General Order 12.03 Procedure When a Firearm is Discharged. Section B of that Order now details the membership, meeting and authority of a Shooting Review Board. The most recent revision of SUDPS General Order 12.03 reflects the most recent changes.

POLICY

The Santa Clara County Sheriff's Office (SCCSO) may exercise the option to conduct a Shooting Review Board that involves a Stanford University Department of Public Safety (SUDPS) Deputy. In this case, Sheriff's Office General Order 12.03 Procedure When A Firearm is Discharged, Section B pertaining to the convening of a Shooting Review Board, shall apply in addition to SUDPS General Orders. Deputies shall be familiar with Section B of General Order 12.03 that defines the membership, meetings and authority of a Shooting Review Board.
